The meeting was called to order at 9am. 12 people attended the meeting. The first order of business was election of officers.

Amy Klebe described the Boot Lake water quality monitoring program and the status of zebra mussels in the lake. Water quality reports are also on the website. There is a loon nest on the island and we are watching for chicks

Webmaster Dick Kelm updates the website regularly. A motion passed unanimously to thank Dick for his faithful and outstanding job with the website.

A discussion of placing buoys near the island for boat speed control brought no results in that we do not have any authority to place buoys in the water.

The meeting adjourned at 10am.
